Not only does this waste time and money, but it also reduces visibility into signature status and increases legal and compliance risks.

Adobe Sign eliminates inefficient, manual tasks by seamlessly connecting with existing IT systems, including Microsoft Dynamics 365. With Adobe Sign, your salespeople can send, track, and sign documents without leaving the Dynamics 365 application. That helps keep everyone productive, and it reduces the IT involvement needed to set up, manage, and maintain a smoothly running system. Adobe Sign is embedded in multistep Dynamics 365 workflows and accelerates time to revenue by completely automating the process.

Because so much of the process—from managing contacts to signing the contract—can happen in Dynamics 365, no additional management is needed, and no new accounts need to be set up. The same Dynamics 365 sign-in credentials enable users to access Adobe Sign and send out documents for signature, including documents from Microsoft SharePoint. Once documents are signed, the Dynamics 365 records are automatically updated as PDFs and sent to all parties. In a matter of minutes, you can complete an entire closing, approval, or other process.



By integrating Adobe Sign with the Microsoft 365 apps your team is already using, you can eliminate paper-based signature processes and deliver all-digital signing experiences.

Adobe Sign tools are built right into Microsoft 365, so everyone in your organization can transact business and collaborate faster without leaving their Microsoft apps. It's a barrier-free process to go from drafting, say, a nondisclosure agreement (NDA), to routing and editing it internally, to getting client sign-off. This full integration allows your team to easily execute and track deals, projects, and communications. All-digital workflows make it all seamless and simple. Even folder organization and naming is automated, so important information can be viewed on any document from any location.

In addition to enjoying smoother workflows, users can move faster to keep track of data with Microsoft SharePoint and Adobe Sign. Because SharePoint is part of Microsoft 365, you can simplify your processes by easily merging data from a SharePoint list right into a file template. Using SharePoint workflow logic, sales teams can configure who approves and when, based on document type or value. They can see any document's status right in the SharePoint folder or list, and store signed documents wherever they choose.

For organizations using Microsoft Teams, Adobe Sign lets collaborators send documents for signature via a simple tab. A bot allows team members to manage, track, and get notifications for the status of important documents like a contract or agreement. The Adobe Sign integration with Teams is also certified as part of the Microsoft 365 certification program, which ensures that enterprise data privacy and security are protected from the introduction of third-party applications into Microsoft 365.

How the Adobe Sign integration with Microsoft 365 cut turnaround time by 13 days.

Situation: More than a fundraising organization.

The Iowa State University Foundation raises funds that support students, faculty, buildings, and programs at Iowa State University (ISU). "We also work with donors and the university to make sure that donors' generous gifts are used in a way that is meaningful to them," said Dave Thalacker, PhD, former senior director of IT **Operations and Network Security.**

The key to developing and ensuring meaningful gifts is clear communication with donors, ISU, and other stakeholders. As a result, each donation involves a lot of unique paperwork. Before Adobe Sign, compliance documents and approvals were printed on paper and individually mailed to each stakeholder. The average turnaround time for approvals was 81 days.

Solution: Speed up the flow with Adobe and Microsoft.

The foundation decided to implement an e-signature solution to modernize and streamline this workflow. Adobe Sign quickly fit into existing workflows, improved turnaround times and compliance, and reduced waste.

With Adobe Sign and Microsoft 365, the donor compliance team now sends electronic copies of agreements directly to a stakeholder's email inbox. Signers can view and sign agreements in minutes, without downloading more apps or setting up a special account. Agreements can be sent to multiple signers simultaneously, reducing turnaround times if one signer is delayed. That's just the beginning.

Switching to Adobe Sign and using Microsoft 365, the ISU Foundation has:

- Cut approval times by 13 days, getting funds to recipients faster
- Reduced errors and manual administrative tasks by leveraging Microsoft integration
- Lowered costs and paper waste by reducing the need for printing

How the state saved money, improved citizen services, and got rid of paper.

With the people of Hawaii spread across multiple islands, the state government has adopted digital processes to reach all 1.4 million citizens quickly and efficiently.

Providing faster service.

Using Adobe Sign for its electronic signature needs, the state can now deliver exceptional and intelligent services faster than ever before. The approval process for documents related to new citizen services now takes a matter of hours rather than two weeks or more. People can sign documents on their laptops, tablets, or even mobile phones in seconds.

Enhancing efficiency, transparency, and accountability.

Hawaii has saved its taxpayers millions, made the signature process more efficient, and improved both the security and traceability of sensitive documents. This is thanks in part to the seamless integration between Adobe Sign, Microsoft Outlook, and Microsoft SharePoint.

The Hawaii Department of Health uses Adobe Sign to manage signed immunization forms for 180,000 students in K–12 schools. Parents and guardians can sign the forms electronically, making it faster and easier to comply with this annual process.

Likewise, the Adobe Sign integration has dramatically improved the workflow associated with travel reimbursements. What once involved paper documents and three levels of approval signatures is now a streamlined, integrated workflow.


