Adobe co-founder Dr John Warnock launched the paper-to-digital revolution with an idea he called, "The Camelot Project".







1993

Improved password encryption for increased security with device-independent formatting.






2001

Adobe Systems announced its acquisition of Sign which would become the basis for the Adobe Sign product.






2015
