
Remove manual tasks.



Leading biopharmaceutical company Regeneron processes thousands of contracts a year. It partnered with Adobe to deliver more efficient, scalable experiences for patients, as well as its manufacturing and legal teams. It prioritised Acrobat Sign integrations with Microsoft apps like Teams, Word and Excel to speed up the signing process significantly.

The company also used automations to generate contract offers and signature requests, reducing processing time by 96% – from two hours to a little under five minutes.

"Adobe Acrobat Sign increases internal efficiencies, but it also allows us to improve how we interact with signers by giving them a fast, easy and touchless method of handling documents," says Anand Shah, senior manager of service delivery for Regeneron.
